Agreed Report

- 1. The Principal informed the Board of the plans to deploy CLASS hours granted by the Department of Education to assist students who had been negatively impacted by Covid 19.
- 2. The Board commended The Director of Adult Education, Ms Máire Ní Scanaill and the Assistant Director of Adult Education, Ms Maria Furlong for a comprehensive and engaging programme of Adult Education for the community.
- 3. There have been a number of School Events since the last Board meeting including.
 - i. A Fancy dress day for Pieta House which raised €800.
 - ii. There were two Parent Information Evenings for parents of prospective students, both of which sold out. The Board commended the team and students for an informative and positive event.
 - iii. A trip to Iceland led by Ms Joanne Barry, Mr Colm Hyde and Ms Lourda Halvey.
 - iv. The Junior Hurlers had a decisive win in their first match. GAA,

 - v. There was €1300 raised for the charity Soley Haiti and International Day of the Girl. The Board commended Ms Joanne Barry for her leadership of this event.
 - vi. The School Musical, Grease was a tremendous success and brought huge enjoyment to the audience and cast alike. The Board

expressed its. thanks Ms Bernie Sullivan, Ms Michelle Mather and Ms Sinead Caffrey, for their tremendous work and to the students for their display of creativity and talent. The Board also expressed its gratitude to St Mary's GAA Club for their partnership in this production in allowing the school to use their facilities.
